# 1. Hidden Features & Tips

- S Pen Hacks
- Bluetooth Air Actions: Use the S Pen button as a remote shutter, media controller, or presentation tool.
- Screen-off Memo: Write notes instantly by pulling out the S Pen when the screen is off.
- Smart Select: Extract text from images or create GIFs using the S Pen toolbar.
- · One UI Tricks
- Second Screen (Windows): Use "Second Screen" in Samsung Flow to turn the Tab S6 into a wireless display for your PC.
- DEX Mode: Switch to Desktop Mode for a PC-like experience (connect via HDMI using a USB-C hub).
- Edge Panels: Customize quick-access apps, tools, and clipboard history.
- · Performance Tweaks
- Enable Developer Options: Tap Build Number 7 times in Settings > About Tablet.
- Force GPU Rendering (for smoother UI)
- Reduce Animations (set to 0.5x in Window/Transition/Animator scale)
- Game Booster: Optimize performance in Settings > Advanced Features > Game Booster.

# 3. Gaming & Emulation Performance

- The Snapdragon 855 still holds up well in 2024:
- Native Games: Runs Gen shin Impact, COD Mobile, and Fort NITE at medium-high settings.
- · Emulation:
- PS2 (AetherSX2): Playable at 2x resolution (some slowdowns in heavy games).
- GameCube (Dolphin): Runs full speed at 1080p.
- Switch (Skyline/Yuzu): Limited compatibility (2D games work well).
- Tip: Use Performance Mode in Game Booster for smoother gameplay.

# 4. Battery Life & Charging

- Screen-on Time: ~8-10 HRS (mixed usage), ~6 HRS (heavy gaming).
- · Charging:
- Supports 15W fast charging (takes ~2h for full charge).
- Battery Saver Tip: Use Dark Mode + 60Hz to extend life.

# 5. Software & Customization

- Best Custom ROMs (If You Want Android 13/14)
- Line age OS 20 (Android 13): Stable, but loses S Pen features.

- Samsung One UI Ports: Rare, but some DEVS keep updating older tabs.
- Warning: Unlocking bootloader voids warranty and breaks Wide vine L1 (Netflix HD).
- Best Launchers
- · Niagara Launcher (Minimalist)

- Nova Launcher (Highly customizable)

## 7. Common Issues & Fixes

- Slow Charging? Try a different 25W+ PD charger (Tab S6 caps at 15W, but some chargers work better).
- S Pen Not Connecting? Re-pair via Settings > Advanced Features > S Pen.
- Wi-Fi Drops? Reset network settings or try 2.4GHz instead of 5GHz.
- LAGGY UI? Clear cache in Recovery Mode (Power + Vol Up).

#### 1. Advanced S Pen & DEX Hacks

- · S Pen as a Full Remote Control
- Custom Air Actions: Use apps like Button Mapper to assign double-press/long-press gestures to the S Pen button (e.g., launch camera, toggle flashlight).
- PPT Control: In Microsoft PowerPoint, use the S Pen as a laser pointer/slide navigator via Bluetooth.
- DEX Mode Pro Tips
- Linux on DEX (RIP, but alternatives exist):
- Use Ter mux + ANDRONIX for a full Linux GUI (requires root for best performance).
- Hidden DEX Feature: Connect to a monitor via USB-C to HDMI, then use wireless keyboard/mouse for a desktop setup.

## 2. Hardware Mods & Repair ability

- · Battery Replacement:
- i Fixit Score: 4/10 (glued battery, requires heat gun).
- Cost: ~\$50 for OEM battery + tools.
- · Storage Upgrade:
- Soldered storage (no internal upgrades), but use a 1TB microSD formatted as internal storage (slower, but works).
- Cooling Mod: Apply thermal paste to the SoC (requires disassembly) for sustained gaming performance.

## 3. Niche Software & Workarounds

- Forced 90Hz Refresh Rate (Root Required)
- Alternative: Use ADB to reduce animation scales to 0.5x for a smoother feel.
- · Netflix HD & DRM Fixes
- Wide vine L1: Ensure DRM Info app shows "L1" (if downgraded to L3, flash stock firmware).
- Netflix 1080p: Use MAGISK + LIBOEMCRYPTO disabler (requires root).

## 4. Audio & Video Enhancements

- · Lossless Audio
- USB-C DAC Support: Works with FLIO KA3 (24-bit/384kHz) for audiophile-grade output.
- LDAC Codec: Enable in Developer Options for high-res Bluetooth audio.
- HDR+ MODDING
- Force HDR on apps like YouTube via LIB HOUDINI (Google how to patch for Snapdragon 855).

# 5. Security & Privacy Tweaks

- Firewall: Use Net Guard (no-root) to block ads/trackers system-wide.
- Kernel Hardening: Flash LineageOS with MicroG to de-Google and improve privacy.
- Secure Folder Alternatives: Use Shelter (FOSS) to create isolated work profiles.

# 7. Extreme Battery Saving

- ADB Command: ABD shell settings put global low \_ power 1 (forces CPU throttling).
- 0% Brightness Hack: Enable Extra Dim in Settings + AMOLED Black themes.
- Disable Sensors: Use Package Disabler to kill always-on sensors (e.g., accelerometer).

#### 8. Resurrection Guide for Aging Tab S6

- · If Your Device Feels Slow
- Factory Reset + Don't Restore Backup (start fresh).
- Disable Bloat:

- ABD shell pm disable-user --user 0 <package.name>
- (Target packages like com .face book .app manager).
- Swap to F2FS: Format /data as F2FS (requires TWRP + custom kernel).

# 1. Engineering Mode Secrets (Proceed with Caution)

- Galaxy Tab S6 SM T865 Unlock Hidden Hardware Controls
- Dial \*#0\*# in Samsung Phone app → access 60+ diagnostic tests:
- AMOLED Burn-In Check (Red/Green/Blue/White screens)
- Pressure Sensor Calibration (S Pen hover accuracy)
- Secret 5G Band Test (Despite lacking 5G hardware)
- Overclocking the Snapdragon 855
- Root Required: Flash Franco Kernel or Smurf Kernel
- Push CPU to 2.96GHz (from stock 2.84GHz)
- Under volt GPU for better thermals using KCAL
- Warning: May reduce chip lifespan by 20-30%

# 2. Transforming into a Full Linux PC

- Dual Boot Android + Ubuntu
- Install Multi ROM TWRP (Custom recovery)
- Flash UB Touch (Ubuntu 22.04 LTS for ARM)
- Performance: Runs LibreOffice/GIMP at 80% desktop speed
