# The Unspoken Psychological War

- When Benzema drops deep, PSG's CBs always follow him, leaving space for Vinicius/Rodrygo.
- 2022 Flashback: Benzema's hat-trick came from Marquinhos stepping up unnecessarily.
- The Psychological Warfare Manual
- The Bernabéu Effect
- PSG players report hearing phantom whistles during away games, even in silent moments.
- Data shows: PSG's pass accuracy drops 7% in the second half at Bernabéu.
- The Mbappé Mind Games
- Madrid players never foul him hard they want him unharmed for his future transfer.
- · But they constantly talk to him in games:
